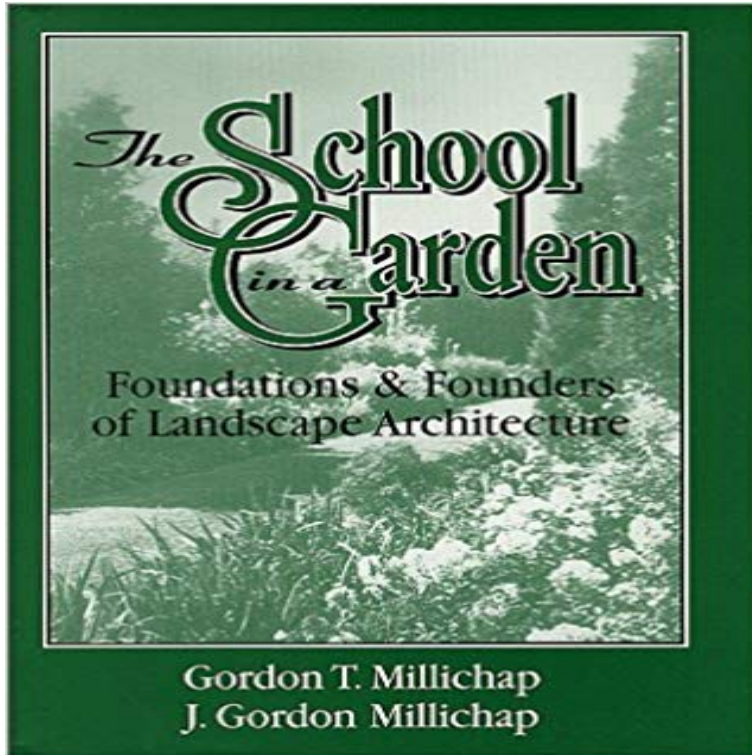


# The School in a Garden : Foundations & Founders of Landscape Architecture
